

# General Conditions

Pony Club Rules apply.

All competitors must be fully paid up members of the Pony Club or an Affiliated Riding Club. Pony Club members must have attended rallies regularly and have DC/Sec's signature on entry form.

No entries can be accepted over the telephone.

No horse/pony to be ridden more than once.

No horse/pony under 5 years of age.

Hats that conform to either (A) PAS 015:1998 or EN 1384:1996 or BS EN 1384:1997 and display the BSI Kitemark; (B) Snell E2001 with the official Snell label & number or (C) AS/NZS 3838 1998 or AS/NZS 3838 2003 with the SAI Global symbol must be worn with a chin strap, fastened at all times when mounted. A cover shall be worn, which for dressage and show jumping must be either dark blue or black. **For cross country a jockey skull cap with no fixed peak must be worn.**

An effective body protector must be worn for the cross country phase. Body protectors should neither impede flexibility nor balance. It is recommended that a rider's body protector should not be more than 2% of their body weight. **Any rider using the Bodyeage Exo-Skeleton body protector must lodge a key with the Secretary on collection of their number bib. If a rider chooses to wear an air vest it must only be used in addition to a normal body protector and in the event of a fall, it must be fully deflated or removed before continuing.** Medical arm bands are compulsory for the cross-country phase. (Available to purchase at event at £3.50 each.)

Health & Safety: The Organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health & safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all Officials and Stewards.

No claim can be entertained by the Ludlow Hunt Branch of the Pony Club, or the Organisers, or the Land Owners for any injury, loss or damage caused to, or suffered by any horse, pony, competitor, onlooker, attendant or other person or vehicle or any other property, in connection with or arising from this event, whether or not the said injury, loss or damage is caused by the negligence, breach of contract, or in any way whatsoever by the Organisers, their officials or Stewards.

Riding Club members are reminded that they are not covered by Pony Club Insurance and should have their own.

The decision of the Chief steward is final. In the event of an objection or dispute arising, the objection must be lodged within 15 minutes of the incident, in writing with the secretary and be accompanied by a £10.00 deposit. The findings of the Organisers will be final.

The organisers reserve the right to cancel should the weather be unsuitable. In this event £5.00 will be retained from each entry to cover administration costs.

–Classes 1 & 2 will ride THE PONY CLUB D LEVEL DRESSAGE TEST WALK & TROT (2012)  
Classes 3, 4, 5, 6 will ride The Pony Club Introductory Test 2007  
The test may be commanded in classes 1 & 2 only.  
These tests can be found on the pony club website (dressage section)

## **CROSS COUNTRY & SHOW JUMPING**

Classes 1 and 2 Fences approximately 0.60m / 1'6"  
Classes 3 and 4 . Fences approximately 0.75m / 2'3"  
Classes 5 and 6 Fences approximately 0.85m / 2'6"

### **CLASS 1. Beginners Mini 10 years and under**

Entry fee £21.00 (LHPC members £19.00)

### **CLASS 2. Beginners Mini 11 years and over**

Entry fee £21.00 (LHPC members £19.00)

*Classes 1 and 2 are for members of any branch of the Pony Club. Combination of rider and pony never to have been placed in any horse trials/ODE including mini. Leading Rein permitted (but will incur penalty points) for the sj and xc phases of these classes. These classes may be combined if insufficient numbers.*

### **CLASS 3. Mini 14 years and under**

Entry fee £24.00 (LHPC members £22.00)

### **CLASS 4. Mini 15 years and over & Riding Club Members**

Entry fee £24.00 (LHPC members £22.00)

*Classes 3 and 4 (approx. 2'3") are for members of any branch of the Pony Club or Riding Club. Combination of rider and horse/pony never to have been placed in any horse trials/ODE excluding mini. There will be plenty of "L" fences to help competitors complete the XC course. These classes may be combined if insufficient numbers..*

### **CLASS 5. Novice 14 years and under**

Entry fee £26.00 (LHPC members £24.00)

### **CLASS 6. Novice 15 years and over & Riding Club Members**

Entry fee £26.00 (LHPC members £24.00)

*Classes 5 & 6 (approx. 2'6") are for members of any branch of the Pony Club or Riding Club. Combination of horse/pony and rider not to have been placed 1st or 2nd more than once in horse trials/ODE excluding mini. "L" options will be given at the more difficult XC fences to help competitors complete the course.*
