The Shropshire South Riding Club is strongly committed to encouraging all Members to take part in all the club activities in which the health and safety of each individual is always our main concern.

The Shropshire South Riding Club has undertaken Risk Assessments in order to anticipate the potential hazards to competitors or members while they are undertaking clinics, competing in events or taking part in Riding Club activities. Reasonable measures have therefore been put in place in order to address these risks and reduce them, as much as is possible.

For these measures to be effective, each individual must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and conduct themselves in such a way that they do not put themselves or anyone else at risk. They must therefore obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards at all times. Potential and actual health and safety hazards, risks, accidents and incidents should be reported without delay to a Club Officer or Steward.
