Please ensure that when completing your video all current government COVID guidance is adhered to. See rules/format below. Juniors are BRC junior criteria. Grass or surface arena may be used with correct and clear letters.

Rosettes will be awarded from 1st to 6th place assuming sufficient entries.

Points towards the SSRC Dressage Championships 2021 will be awarded (as per SSRC website) to members only.

- 1. BRC Walk & Trot Dressage Test (2020)
- 2. BRC Dressage Test D2 (2020) Prelim level.
- 3. BRC Horse Trials Test 90Q (2020) Prelim level
- 4. BRC Horse Trials Test HT 100+Q (2020) Novice Level.

Videos must be landscape and filmed behind C, getting close ups where possible, full movements must be seen. Sound must be kept on, no teaching or use of voice permitted. Callers may only be used in relation to covid guidance. Video must not have any edits or cuts. Please start and finish the film with enough time for us to see horse for a few seconds, before and after, first and last movement. N.B Test must be filmed for this current competition – therefore we are asking video people to say the date at the start of the video please!! Please email video or upload it to YouTube and then provide the link to the entry. Scoresheets and rosettes will be returned to you and results will be posted on the club's website and facebook page.
