Booking & Payment

• Camp Cost: £320

• Deposit: £50 (non-refundable & non-transferable) via MRL

• Balance: 3 monthly instalments of £90 by 30th June, 31st July and 27th August 2025 via BACS

• Failure to pay by **27**th **August** may result in your place being offered to someone else, with the deposit forfeited.

Refund Policy

- Refund **only if** your place is filled from the waitlist.
- From **29**th **August (5pm)**: **No refunds** under any circumstances, as the club will have paid the venue and catering costs by then.
- Any withdrawals must be made via email to: lizworrall33@hotmail.co.uk
- No discount/refund for late arrival/early departure or missed sessions.

Membership

- Camp is open to full, senior SSRC members only.
- If your membership lapses after booking, you have **7 days to renew** or lose your place (no refund).

Camp for Humans

- Includes 2 nights, 3 days
- All meals, from Friday evening to Sunday lunchtime.
- Tea, coffee & squash will be available.
- · Alcohol is permitted.
- Limited fridge space.
- Dietary needs must be declared on the booking form.
- Bring your own cutlery & crockery, mug and a refillable water bottle.

Ridden Sessions

• Camp includes **5 sessions**. Shared and grouped by ability, so please be realistic about you and your horse's ability when selecting.

- There will be a minimum **1-hour rest** between sessions.
- No timetable changes unless an error is made.
- Instructor lineup may change at short notice.

Human Accommodation

- Stay in trailer, lorry, tent, or caravan (no electric hookup).
- Toilets and showers available.
- **On-site accommodation** is limited; priority to SSRC Camp helpers. Remaining spaces will be released on a first come basis.
 - o Cost: approx. £30 per room/night
 - Further details of the available accommodation and how to book will be emailed out at a later date.

Visitors

- Must notify organisers before arrival.
- No under-18s in clubhouse, yard, or camping areas.

Camp for Horses

- Horses must be 4 years old and over
- Horses are stabled (no turnout). In-hand grazing only.
- Bring own buckets, mucking out tools, feed, and forage. No hay/haylage for sale onsite.
- Stables come with 1 rubber mat and vary by size (assigned based on horse height).
- Straw (£6 /bale) available—can be book and paid for via SSRC. Please email lizworrall33@hotmail.co.uk to order
- Stables must be **left empty** by **5pm on last day**—will be checked by committee.

General Info & Rules

Arrival: Between 9am and 12pm on Friday ready for your first session just after lunch

Departure: 5pm Sunday

Documents: Horse passport, current flu vaccination (within 12 months, not in last 7

days)

Insurance: Third-party liability required

Dogs: Not allowed

Quiet Hours: No stable yard access between 9pm-6am, unless emergency

Horse Feeding Times: 8am & 6pm (except discreet feeding)

Safety:

- Do not participate in sessions above your ability
- Riding hats should meet BRC safety standards and always required when mounted; non peaked skull caps & body protectors for SJ, XC & arena eventing
- No tying up outside stables
- Hand grazing only in designated area
- No smoking/vaping except in grazing paddock—dispose of butts properly.

- No horses in camping area unless emergency
- Muck tools stored in designated areas, not blocking hay space
- No shared tools or tack
- No hacking alone—inform organisers before and after hacking
- No feeding/treating other horses
- Clean up all mess, including from wash bays—fines apply
- Stable check required before departure

Important Notes

- Report any issues to organisers immediately—we cannot resolve complaints retrospectively.
- Camp is organised by volunteers—a lot of time goes into planning the timetable in advance so please be respectful and patient.
- Disruptive or abusive behaviour may result in **immediate removal with no refund**.
- The venue operates a **quiet noise policy**—no loud conversations or singing after 9.30pm please.

We will send out a camp survey in July to find out: your riding ability so we can group you accordingly, clinic preferences, special dietary requests, straw request and any special requirements for your horse. **We will try and accommodate all requests if possible.**
