- Maximum of two teams per club
- Teams are to be made up of either 3 or 4 riders competing in classes 2,4 and 6 – 3 scores are to count
- Team scores will be totalled and the team with the LOWEST total score of 3 will be declared the winner
- All scores will be counted towards individual placings
- Dressage scores will be converted to % penalties which will be added to show jumping penalties. The class winner will be the combination with the lowest total penalties (% dressage penalties + show jumping penalties).
- In the case of a tie, the dressage collectives will determine the winner.
- Horses will be restricted to entering two Combined Training classes, or one Combined Training and two dressage or two clear round show jumping classes
- Dressage will be held the large outdoor school, 40m x 20m arenas.
- Warm up will be in the Poolands, the smaller indoor arena
- Show Jumping will be in the International indoor arena – there will be two warm-up fences in the large arena that riders are able to use before they start the round
- If entries warrant, each class can be split into Junior and Senior sections
- Clear round will be offered on the day if time allows

Rules and Regulations

- BBC will not tolerate any verbal or physical abuse of its members, competitors, spectators or animals and reserves the right to ask any person deemed to be behaving inappropriately to leave the showground.
- Horses will only be allowed to jump two courses, including a clear round
- Any animal behaving in a manner which may pose a danger to other attendees may be asked to leave the ring / show ground – no refund of entry fees will be made
- Hard Hats must be worn at all times when mounted conforming to current BRC recognised standards.
- Stallions must display a stallion disc at all times
- Horses or ponies must be at least 4 years of age to compete
- A Safeguarding member of the organising committee is available all day – contact the secretary if needed
- Horses must not be unattended tied to the outside of vehicles.
- All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and all fouling must be removed
- Directions of any steward or representative of BBC must be followed, failure to do so may result in elimination and / or being asked to leave a class / the show ground. No refund of entry fees will be made.
- The judge's decision and that of the BBC Officials is final.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse admission to any class, and reserve the right to alter the schedule and to close or cancel classes.
- Entries withdrawn AFTER closing date will be charged for and may not be carried forward.
- Horses must be up to date with their annual vaccinations

COVID

- All current covid restrictions will apply.
- If you have any symptoms, do not attend.
