Where MT refers to Mercian Teams, MI refers to Mercian Individuals and I refers to Individual entries.

- Each Mercian Team is to be made of 4 horse and rider combinations – 1 from each class 1 to 4
- 3 scores will count so 3 can enter as a team if needed
- Class 5 and 6 are for individuals, but can be entered as Mercian Individual. These two classes will be run under Open Rules
- Scores will be taken in the form of penalties and the combination with the lowest total score in the class will be deemed the winner.
- In the case of a tie, the dressage collectives will determine the winner.
- Clear round show jumping will be available and can be booked using the entry form
- Dressage will be held in the large outdoor school with two 40m x 20m arenas side by side.
- Warm up will be in the Poolands, the smaller indoor arena
- Show Jumping will be in the International indoor arena – there will be two warm-up fences in the large arena that riders are able to use before they start the round
- If entries warrant, each class can be split into Junior and Senior sections
- Riders can wear Club affiliated colours rather than show jackets. It is recommended that a neck stock is worn but it will be the rider's choice whether to wear one or not.
- It is also recommended that a back protector is worn during the jumping phase but it is also down to the rider to choose whether to wear one or not.

ALL entries are pre-entries, to made using the attached form and sent via E-mail to the entries secretary. They are to be received no later than Monday 16th June

Callers will be available for £1, which must be paid to the caller on the day and before the start of the test.

Rules and Regulations

- BBC will not tolerate any verbal or physical abuse of its members, competitors, spectators or animals and reserves the right to ask any person deemed to be behaving inappropriately to leave the showground.
- Any animal behaving in a manner which may pose a danger to other attendees may be asked to leave the ring / show ground – no refund of entry fees will be made
- Hard Hats must be worn at all times when mounted conforming to current BRC recognised standards.
- Stallions must display a stallion disc at all times
- Horses or ponies must be at least 4 years of age to compete and will not be allowed to enter more than two classes on the day.
- A child protection trained member of the organising committee is available all day – contact the secretary if needed
- Horses must not be left unattended tied to the outside of vehicles, and hay is not to be fed outside the trailer. All muck is to be cleared up and not left behind.
- All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and all fouling must be removed
- Directions of any steward or representative of BBC must be followed, failure to do so may result in elimination and / or being asked to leave a class / the show ground. No refund of entry fees will be made.
- The judge's decision and that of the BBC Officials is final.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse admission to any class, and reserve the right to alter the schedule and to close or cancel classes.
- Entries withdrawn AFTER closing date will be charged for and may not be carried forward.
- Horses must be up to date with their annual vaccinations

Health and Safety

The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards. There will be a human first aider on site.
